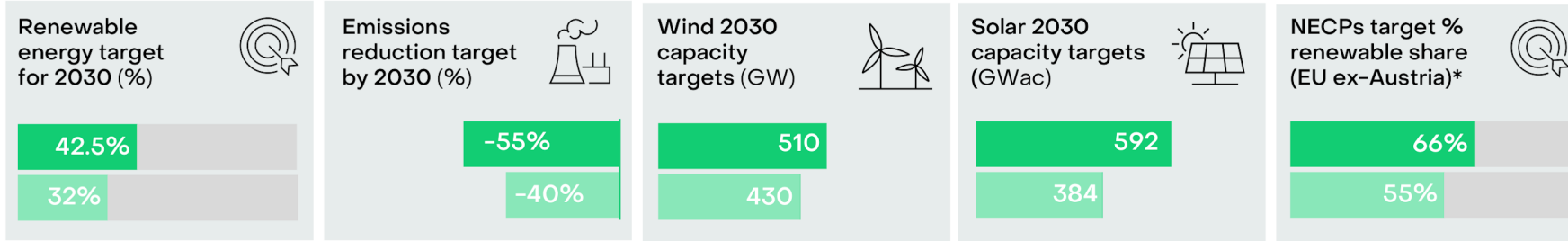


EU energy transition since 2019

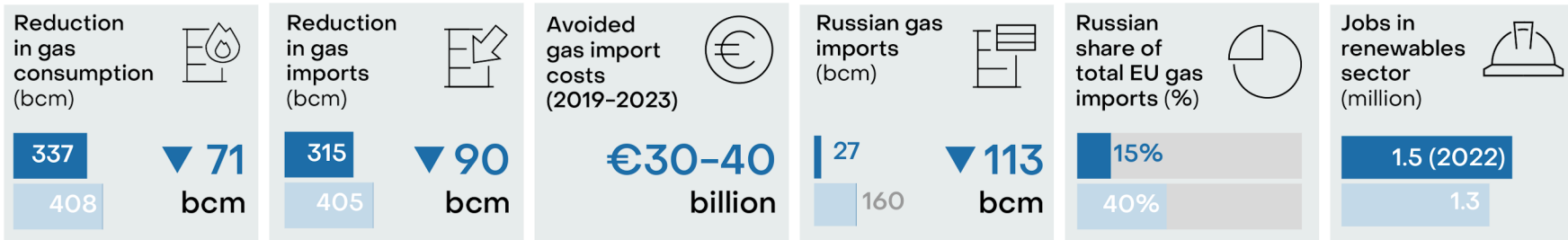

Change in ambition (2019 vs 2023)

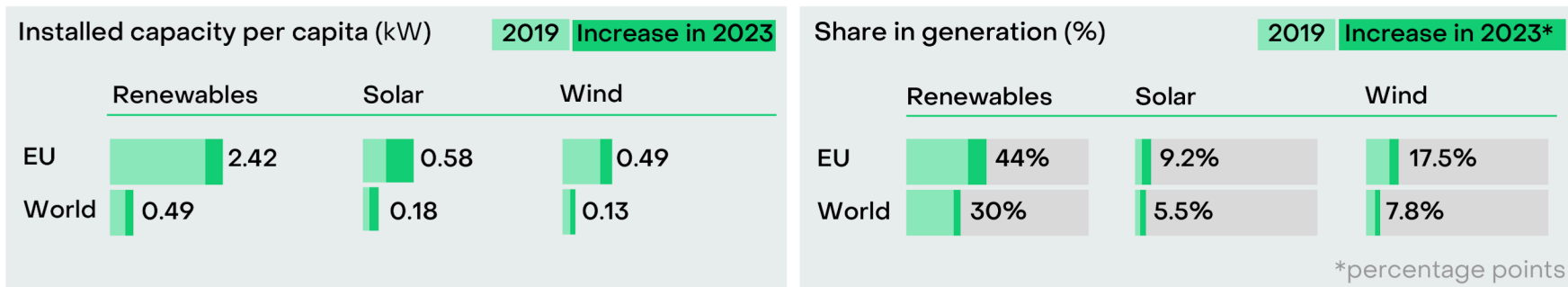


*Austria has not yet submitted an updated draft National Energy and Climate Plan as of May 2024
